PeachWorx: TFCO2 – Manual agent installation.

The TaskForceCO2 console is designed to install the Client on remote PCs. By doing so, the console can keep track of new PCs arriving in the console and can automatically install a client on them.

There may be occasions due to internal network issues where it is not possible to automatically install the TaskForceCO2 Client on one or two PCs using the TaskForceCO2 Console.

Whilst it is not recommended it is possible to install the client manually by following these instructions.

You need to copy the following files from the Windows directory of a PC that has the client on it into the Windows directory of the remote PC.

TFCO2Cli.exe  
TFCO2Cli.ini  
TFCO2Cli.pjb  
TFCO2Cli.sch  
TFCO2VSW.exe

Then go to the Windows directory on the remote PC from a command prompt and type:-

```
TFCO2Cli /install  
TFCO2Cli /start
```

This will install the client on the PC and start the service.

Check that the file TFCO2Cli.ini contains the correct address of the Host PC as below.

```
[Settings]  
Comms Port=6960  
LocalCommsPort=6940  
VisibleShutDownWarnings=0
```

[Server]

Hostname=**your host address needs to be here**

Port=6980

Copying just the file TFCO2Cli.exe and typing TFCO2Cli /install and TFCO2Cli /Start will put the appropriate files in place although you would have to manually edit the TFCO2Cli.ini file and enter the host name of the console.
